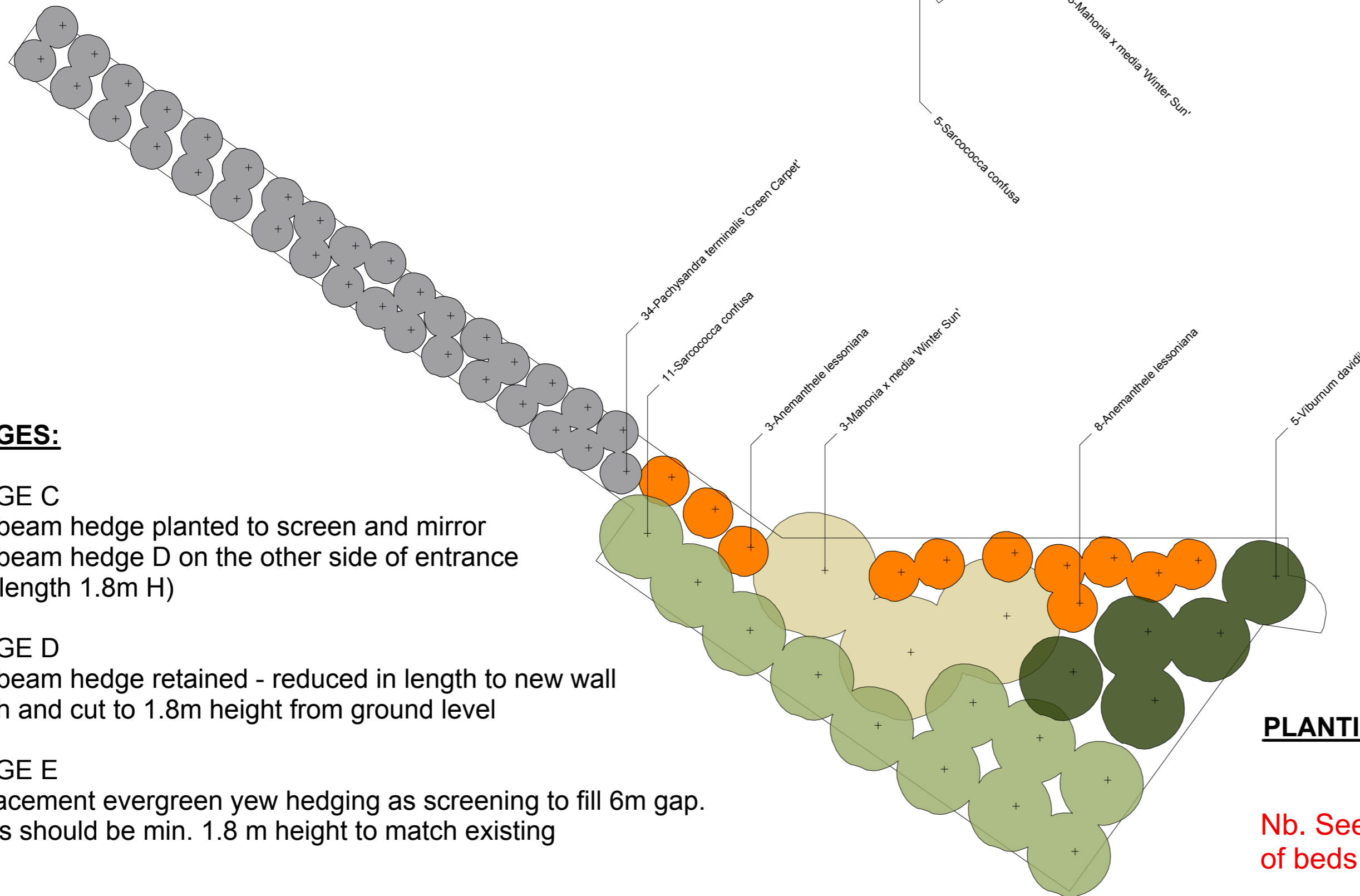
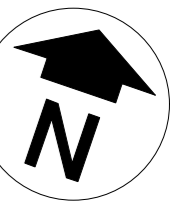
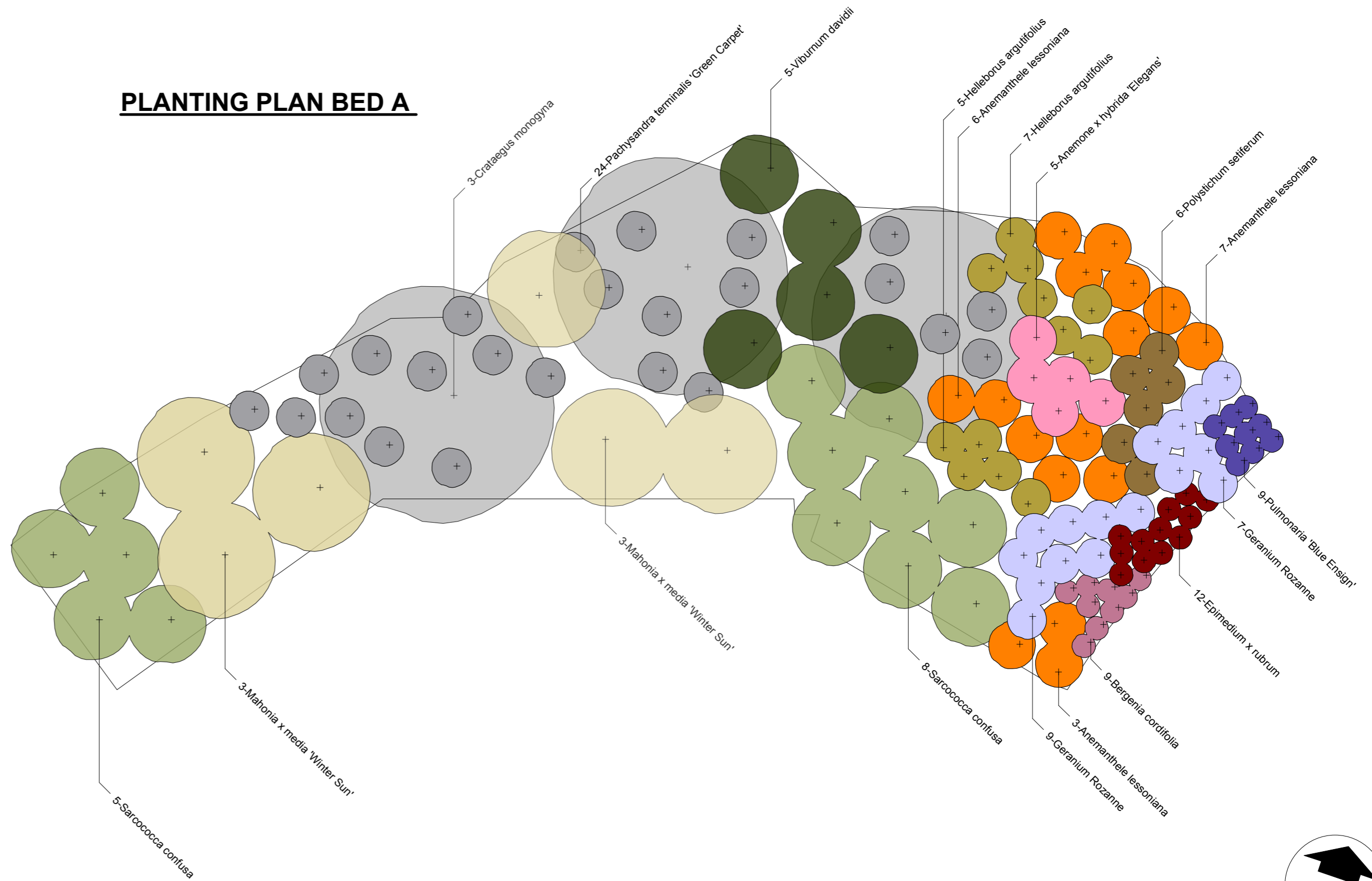

**HEDGE C**  
 Hornbeam hedge planted to screen and mirror  
 Hornbeam hedge D on the other side of entrance  
 (4 m length 1.8m H)

**HEDGE D**  
 Hornbeam hedge retained - reduced in length to new wall  
 length and cut to 1.8m height from ground level

**HEDGE E**  
 Replacement evergreen yew hedging as screening to fill 6m gap.  
 Plants should be min. 1.8 m height to match existing
